In RE this week, the children have started their unit of work on Creation. They have completed an assessment to show their prior understanding from previous years. Throughout the unit, they will be learning about how we can care for God's Kingdom.

In Maths, we have continued our work on addition and subtraction. The children have been using column addition and learning about how they regroup numbers. They have been using manipulatives and drawing pictures to explain their understanding. They have also been considering the efficiency of methods and whether a written method is suitable.

We have now moved on to writing to entertain in English. The children used a picture of an autumn scene as their stimulus for their elicitation task.
