The children have had a fantastic week this week enjoying Science Week. They have worked in small groups to conduct different experiments ranging from creating an invention to transport tomatoes off a table (without dropping them) to building bridges out of lego and exploring different structures.

In Maths, the children have continued their work on multiplication and division. They have been multiplying multiples of ten and 100 and applying this to the formal methods of short multiplication. Next week we will be exploring written methods of division.

In Literacy, we have continued our theme of writing to entertain. We have been exploring the use of different vocabulary in lessons and the impact that powerful verbs have on the reader. We have also explored the use of speech and created dialogue to advance a story and entertain the reader.
