In English this week, the children have been immersing themselves with writing to entertain. They have looked at a range of different styles of writing, including scripts, poems, descriptions and different types of narratives.

In maths, the children have been working on adding tens and ones to 3 digit numbers. This has involved crossing boundaries so needing to rename and regroup ones as tens! They have looked at different strategies they can do mentally as well as the more formal written method of column addition.

The Maples have been experimenting with water colours this week to produce their final draft of their sketch. They used different techniques to paint the sky and sea for their sketch, which they will then add details to using pastels and chalk.
