Dear Families,

Welcome back to the New Year and Spring Term! I hope you had an enjoyable, restful Christmas break. The Maples have dived back in to learning this week with lots of enthusiasm and are excited about their new units of work.

In English, the Maples have been looking at writing to persuade. They have read lots of different texts this week which all persuade the reader in some way. The children have identified similar features between the texts and focussed on different persuasive devices.

In Maths, the Maples have started their new unit focussed on multiplication and division. They have focussed on the 3 and 4 times tables and the different ways in which they can be represented. They have looked for the patterns in the tables and how this creates fact families and known facts which can be used for trickier calculations.

In R.E., the children have continued their exploration of Christianity through the idea of incarnation and God. This week, they have explored the idea of the Holy Trinity and what this means. They have read a passage from the gospel of Mark to look for suggestions and different representations of the Holy Trinity.

Finally, the children have enjoyed lots of independent reading this week, to pick a new book and find something that intrigues and excites them. Hopefully they are looking forward to sharing this with you at home!
