We have had a fantastic week of learning in The Maples!

The Maples took part in a morning of P.E. related activities ran by the Year 5 play leaders, who have been working alongside Young Leaders from The Spires College. They lead The Maples in different activities, involving throwing, catching and of course having fun! It was a fantastic, collaborative experience, where we learnt lots of new skills and got to work with different children who inspired us to be leaders in the future.
