We have been immersed the land, culture and religion of the Maya this week! We have learnt about a few of their staggering 150 plus Gods that they still worship today, and discussed why they had so many. We have also learnt about the foods that they ate as well as how and when they were grown. We have also learnt about how the Maya transported their gods and everyone has designed a Maya-esque form of transport that we will make next week. The children have also continued to compare how the Ancient Maya compared to the Anglo-Saxons that were living in Britain at that time. The class then debated which has left the biggest legacy!

In Science, the children have continued to learn about the human body. We have focused on how nutrients and minerals are transported through our digestive system and into our circulatory system.
