In R.E this week, the children began our new topic on the Gospels. They applied their inference skills from our reading sessions to interpret and explain what they thought was happening and who the people were. They then began reading some Gospels before interpreting what they believed to be the key messages and ideas from the texts.

In Maths this week, the children have worked exceptionally hard to deepen their understanding of addition and subtraction of fractions. Once we agreed the procedural methods to solve these questions, we used our knowledge to tackle a variety of reasoning problems.



In Literacy, the children have worked extremely hard to use precise and effective adjectives within their writing. After watching a clip from Blue Planet 2, the children attempted to carefully craft a description of the marine animals, thinking about their effect on the reader. To finish the week, the children applied their learning to write their introduction to their fact file, using their research project to support them.
