Dear Families,

This week, the Oaks have started a Spirited Arts project this week. They have been asked to design and construct a piece of artwork using a medium of their choice. The children had three different themes to choose from: holy spaces, looking for God or making peace. They have really enjoyed drafting their artwork and experimenting with different techniques and critiqued their drafts with a partner to make improvements for their final piece. Finally, the children wrote a 400 word explanation of the choices that they made in their artwork and what different aspects of their picture represented.

In RE, the children completed their end of unit assessment where they explained their understanding of what they had learned. We discussed different theories and the children answered the question: Creation and Science – Conflicting or complimentary?

We have been continuing our work with decimals for this unit. We have been adding and subtracting decimals and exploring different methods that we can use. The children have combined this learning with finding the perimeter of rectangles.
