Wow, we have had another fantastic week in the Rowans! In Science this week, the Rowans have enjoyed exploring plants. They worked together in an investigation to put cress into different conditions e.g. dark or light and then challenged themselves to write predictions as to whether they thought the cress would grow. The Rowans also enjoyed using their scientific knowledge to write instructions to plant a seed and then had a go at planting their own bean seed at home. They were excited to take responsibility to care for their plant and monitor its progress. As part of our Science learning, the Rowans also learnt about the life cycle of plants and the different processes involved. I was really impressed to see them using scientific terms such as germination and photosynthesis in their writing. Well done Rowans!

In Maths this week, the Rowans have been exploring volume and capacity with a focus on a quarter full, half full and full. They challenged themselves to use different units to measure the capacity of different containers and compared them with other containers to see which had more/less.

This week, the Rowans started the 'Golden Mile' this is a new scheme that lots of schools are taking part in to encourage children to participate in more exercise. They need to try to aim to walk a mile a day and get awards when they get to each milestone. The children were very excited to get started and have already achieved a couple of miles. They discovered that one mile is 31 laps of the small playground!
