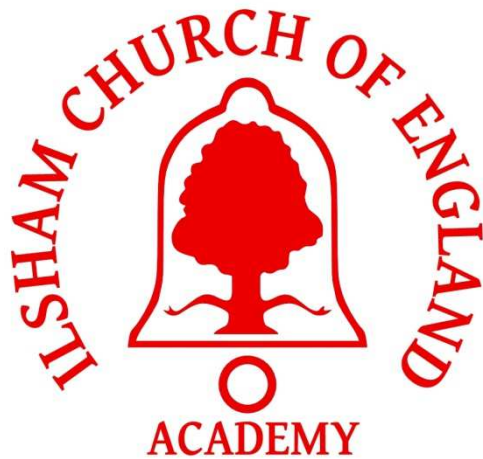

Scratch Club - (Years 3, 4, 5 & 6) - Wednesday

After the success of last terms club Mrs Bennett & Mr Eden will be running this club this summer term.

The Scratch Club is a new computing software we have installed across the Partnership. It is a new programming language that allows children to create interactive stories, animations, games and art. Children will have the opportunity to build computer games using a piece of very intuitive computer coding software. It scaffolds children's coding by showing them how to build games and apps.

Once the basic skills have been learned children will be able to experiment and develop their own ideas. Scratch embraces many areas of mathematics and offers many great learning links. Coding will become an integral part of the new Computing curriculum 2014/15 and encouraging our pupils to start this process will enhance their learning further.

This club will run on a Wednesday after school from 3pm - 4pm for Years 3, 4, 5 & 6. The club will commence on Wednesday 22nd April and will end on Wednesday 8th July. The cost of this club will be £18 for 9 weeks (1st July 2015 is Sports Day) payable in advance.
